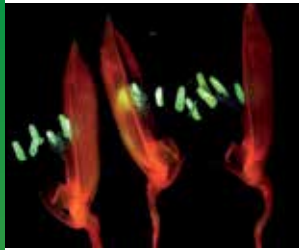
World capital of agricultural research, the city of Montpellier pools many research institutions and universities.
